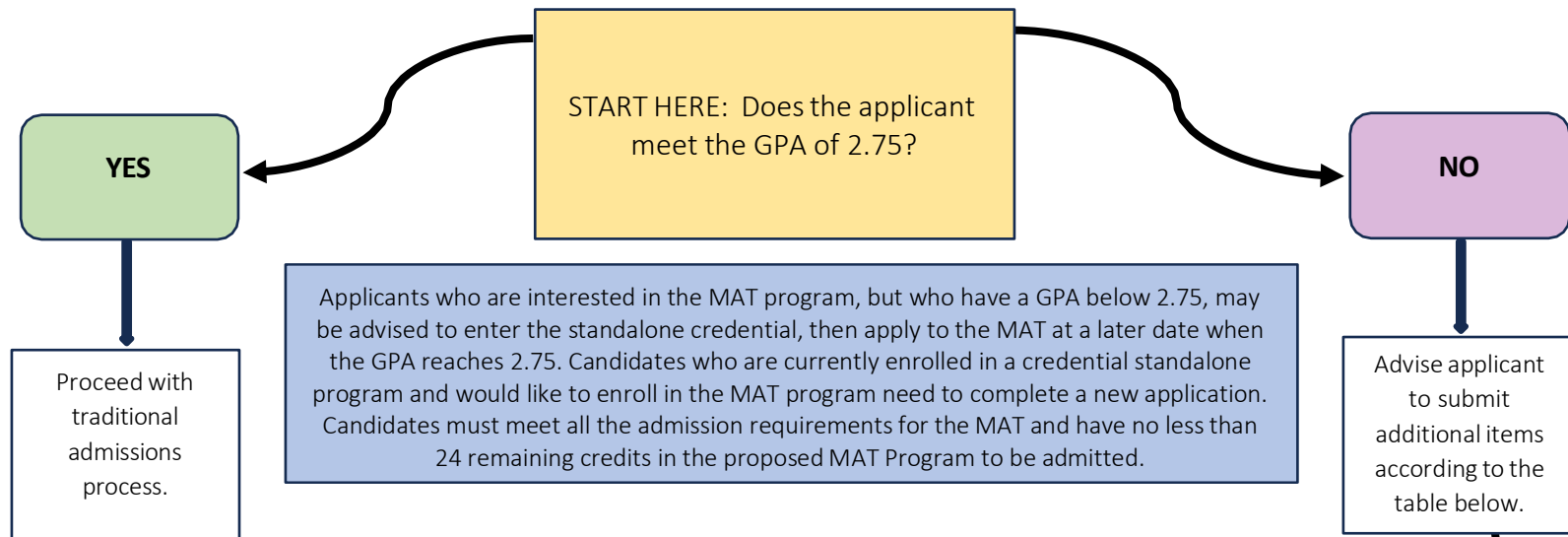


How to Support Teacher Credential Applicant Who Does Not Meet Minimum GPA Requirement for Admission

If an applicant for the standalone teacher credential or MAT program does not meet the minimum GPA requirements (2.75 GPA for both Standalone Teacher Credential and Master of Arts in Teaching), they should be advised that additional requirements must be fulfilled. Please note, this is only a resource and does not supersede language in the university catalog. Admission by Prior Graduate Degree or higher from a regionally accredited institution is a permissible route for candidates seeking admission into the MAT but is not an option for candidates seeking the standalone teacher credential. Otherwise, continue below.
