The scholarship eligibility information below is from Enrollment Management, and is included here for convenience.

Any questions regarding implementation of the scholarship under the policies below should be directed to Enrollment Management.

Scholarship eligibility criteria

- ~ Must be an employee of a participating Scholarship Partner
- ~ A spouse or dependent of a member of an organization would be eligible for the spouse/dependent scholarship
- ~ Student must be admitted to the University and attending during the 2022-23 academic year.
- ~ Must start during the term of the partnership agreement.
- ~ Since partner discount levels (10% for corporate and 20% for marquis) may change over time, depending on the partner organization's level of engagement, the discount the student receives will be the discount level in the agreement at the time that the student is offered their scholarship, **unless** the student breaks catalog with an extended time away from the University (see next item).
- ~ If a student stops out for two years or applies to a new program, they will need to re-apply for admission and they also need to reapply for a scholarship at that time. The reapplying student would be subject to whichever scholarships and agreements are available to them in their specific situation at the time of the re-admit.
- ~ Stop-outs maintain their current scholarship if they return prior to the end of two years, at which point the re-application rules apply.
- ~ Student must remain in good academic and financial standing in accordance with the University's existing catalog.
- ~ Submit the scholarship application no later than one session immediately following the start of the student's eligibility of the qualified academic program. In addition, once the scholarship application is submitted, the scholarship will not be retroactive beyond one session.
- ~ Scholarships will be applied to the current active session/trimester based on date of receipt of the complete scholarship application packet and **cannot be applied retroactively.**
- ~ Students are only eligible for one scholarship, which includes students receiving the military discount.

Off-site cohort minimum class size by program and process to identify the students and % discounts for Financial Aid

The minimum cohort size to qualify for the off-site cohort discount varies by program. The minimum is set so that after attrition, cohorts are still large enough to be able to meet the minimum class size.

If a cohort is made, the Campus Director is responsible for coding the cohort in Salesforce and generating the Salesforce Cohort report identifying the students and percentage discount. The Campus Director then sends the Cohort report to scholarships@umassglobal.edu so that the students can be coded in Banner.

If the minimum cohort size is needed for a program that is not included below, please contact Enrollment Management.

Clarification for School of Ed Programs

As there has been confusion regarding things such as which programs are teaching credentials, etc., please see the additional information below.

~ Assuming the student is covered under a partner agreement, and the agreement allows the program to be discounted, and all other criteria are met, then the following programs are considered to be Teaching Credentials with a 15% discount.

2042 Teaching Credential, Multiple Subject

2042 Teaching Credential, Single Subject

Teaching Credential, Preliminary, Early Childhood Special Ed.

Teaching Credential, Preliminary, Mild/Moderate

Teaching Credential, Preliminary, Mild/Moderate and Moderate/Severe

Note: Added authorizations or an added emphasis are not eligible.

~ Assuming the student is covered under a partner agreement, and the agreement allows the program to be discounted, and all other criteria are met, then the following programs are eligible for a 15% discount under the MAT (Master of Arts in Teaching) umbrella.

MAT, Elementary Education with 2042 Multiple Subject Credential

MAT, Elementary Education with 2042 Single Subject Credential

MAT, Preliminary Ed.S., Mild/Moderate and Moderate/Severe Credential

~ The Ed.D. program has its own initiatives tied to it, although any partner discount (such as 10% or 20%) would apply.

~ All other School of Education Programs that don't already have special pricing through Extended Education and don't fall in one of the SOE-specific discount categories would be eligible for the other discount programs, such as partner discounts, provided the criteria are met.

Students that are getting special pricing through Extended Education are not eligible for discounts on top of that (no double dipping).
