

Program-Specific Vaccination Policies

School of Education:

Proof of vaccines required by the end of the first session of attendance.

- Proof of a current “negative” tuberculosis test that verifies the candidate does not have active tuberculosis or a tuberculosis risk assessment questionnaire administered by a licensed health care provider verifying that the candidate does not have risk factors for tuberculosis.

All Teaching Credential Programs – 2042 Multiple Subject, 2042 Single Subject, and Preliminary Special Education Mild/Moderate/Severe, Early Childhood Special Education

Master of Arts in Educational Leadership and Administration with Preliminary Administrative Services Preliminary Administrative Services Credential

Education Specialist Degree in School Psychology (ED.S.) and a Master of Arts in Educational Psychology with a Pupil Personnel Services Credential in School Psychology, and Pupil Personnel Services Credential in School Counseling

All M.A.T. Programs – Elementary Education, Secondary Education and Special Education

Bachelor’s Degree in Early Childhood Education additionally requires candidates volunteering or working in day care centers and/or family day care homes to provide:

- Proof of immunization against influenza, pertussis, and measles.

Marybelle and S. Paul Musco School of Nursing and Health Professions:

All requirements are due by the end of the first session and are required to stay in compliance (current and updated) throughout your program.

Immunization and Health Screening Requirements:

- Proof of annual negative Tuberculosis (TB) screening:
 - TB blood test (IGRA) OR
 - Negative chest x-ray accompanied by a signed provider negative symptom checklist.
- Proof of completion of Hepatitis A and B immunization series or titer demonstrating immunity.
- Proof of two doses of Measles/Mumps/Rubella (MMR) immunization or titer demonstrating immunity.

Program-Specific Vaccination Policies

- Proof of one Tetanus/diphtheria/acellular pertussis (Tdap) immunization (after 19 years of age) and boosters per the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention's adult vaccination schedule.
- Proof of Chicken Pox (Varicella) immunization or titer demonstrating immunity.
- Proof of annual influenza immunization.

- Proof of COVID Vaccination may be required by potential clinical sites.
- Additional laboratory tests, immunizations, and/or documentation may be required for specific practicum sites.
