Completion of the full CSU or UC IGETC certification (CA), Washington and Oregon state-approved Direct Transfer degrees or other state's equivalent transfer certification prior to the student being admitted, enrolled and attending his/her first session in a bachelor degree program at Brandman satisfies all Brandman University GE requirements except LBSU 300. Students who matriculate to Brandman with partial GE certifications will have their coursework evaluated on a course by course basis to determine appropriate applicability to each general education category.

Lower division courses may be eligible to fulfill upper division major requirements if approved by the Dean of Arts and Sciences, however, lower division coursework will not be applied toward the upper division unit requirement.

This major offers an opportunity for students who have completed specialized training in the fire technology program at Moreno Valley College, beyond the basic fire academy requirements. Firefighter training courses taken at a regionally accredited institution will transfer to Brandman as lower division general elective credit (TRNU-1TR). This opportunity offers students an expedited path to degree completion. Please refer to [Web Advisor](#) for specific institution course approvals.
