The following information is a guide of college courses that transfer to University of Massachusetts Global to fulfill general education requirements.

GE Block Transfer

University of Massachusetts Global accepts the full CSU or UC IGETC general education certification to satisfy all General Education requirements except LBSU 302 & 304 and Degree Qualifications. The Degree Qualifications may be completed through residential coursework taken in the major or through residential electives.

Certification must be completed prior to the student's first term admitted, enrolled and attending. Students who matriculate to University of Massachusetts Global with partial General Education certifications will have their coursework evaluated on a course by course basis to determine appropriate applicability to each general education category.

The General Education Requirements consist of 42 total units.
