This program is designed for counselors, teachers, therapists, medical professionals, artists, and others interested in learning the Art4Healing® method and using the exercises in their own work with children and adults suffering from abuse, illness, grief or stress. Participants will learn how to use the language of color as a way to facilitate creativity and emotional expression through abstract painting on canvas and other visual mediums.

Throughout the certification process, students will be asked to participate and facilitate segments of a workshop. This certificate allows for the individual use of the Art4Healing® methods within private practice as a supplement to existing therapeutic, educational, or artistic programs.

Art & Creativity for Healing Inc. is a nonprofit agency dedicated to providing workshops that help children, teens, and adults suffering from abuse, illness, grief or stress process their feelings using the venue of painting on canvas. The workshops have already helped tens of thousands of individuals, including at-risk and underprivileged youth recovering from child abuse, substance abuse, and gang-related trauma. This method also helps families dealing with chronic and life-threatening illnesses cope with the emotional, spiritual, and physical impact upon their lives. By expressing themselves creatively, participants can document their experience in a profound way, thus creating a healing environment for themselves.

Certificate Requirements

Expressing Feelings with Color

This is the introductory workshop for the Art4Healing® Certificate training. Students will experience the method of Art4Healing® firsthand, expressing feelings through the language of color and painting on canvas.

Level One Facilitator Training

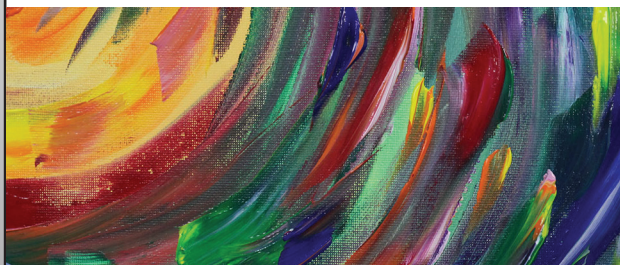
This two-day class is designed to teach students how to run a successful workshop with their own clients including how to create a comfortable and safe environment as well as to practice facilitating projects.

Art4Healing® Beginner, Intermediate, and Advanced Series

Art4Healing® Beginner, Intermediate and Advanced Series contain exercises that are designed to teach participants the language of color and how to express and process emotion through visual art. Participants in the Beginning series use collage, watercolor, acrylic painting and journaling to complete a series of artworks. Intermediate participants complete a second series of artworks using these varied mediums to take the process to a new level of emotional expression. The advanced series focuses on acrylic painting on canvas to explore and process each participant's own creativity on a deeper level through the completion of an additional series of paintings.

Art & Creativity for Healing Workshop Volunteering

Participants must complete the Level One Facilitator Training prior to beginning this portion of the program. To complete the Art4Healing® certification program, participants are required to complete 12 hours of volunteering at our Art4Healing® workshops held on site at our studio, or at any of our 35 partner agencies.
