Degree Requirements & Concentrations/Electives

BA Applied Studies consists of 15 credits in foundation courses and 21 credits of courses in a selected area of emphasis to fulfill the 36 credit requirement for the program.

Students may choose from the following emphases:

- 1. Applied Communication
- 2. Applied Humanities
- 3. Leadership

It is possible for transfer courses to meet course requirements within the emphasis area.
