

## Transfer Guide General Education

## Florence-Darlington Technical College 2011-2012

The following information is a guide of Florence-Darlington Technical College courses that transfer to Brandman University to fulfill general education requirements.

## **GE Block Transfer**

Brandman accepts the full CSU or UC IGETC general education certification to satisfy all GE requirements except LBSU 300, LBSU 302 and University Degree Qualifications. The University Degree Qualifications may be completed through residential coursework taken in the major or through residential electives.

Certification must be completed prior to the student's first term admitted, enrolled and attending. Students who matriculate to Brandman with partial GE certifications will have their coursework evaluated on a course by course basis to determine appropriate applicability to each general education category.

Courses may be approved for more than one area but can only be applied towards one requirement
