LESSON OR UNIT PLAN

Once you are enrolled in the course, download the lesson or unit plan template. You can use the template to create one or more lessons demonstrating strategies you learned from your professional development experience. You will include at least one artifact (e.g., slide presentation, flyer, infographic, etc.) created by you for the lesson(s).

PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT INITIATIVE

Once you are enrolled in the course, download the professional development initiative template. You can use the template to create a training presentation or write up a strategic plan for an initiative. For each option, identify the specific audience and provide at least one artifact (e.g., slide presentation, flyer, infographic, etc.) that would support your presentation or initiative.

TIME LOG
