Completion of the full CSU or UC IGETC certification (CA), Washington and Oregon state-approved Direct Transfer degrees or other state's equivalent transfer certification prior to the student being admitted, enrolled and attending his/her first session in a bachelor degree program at UMass Global satisfies all UMass Global GE requirements except competency LBSC 320 & LBSC 321. Students who matriculate to UMass Global with partial GE certifications will have their coursework evaluated on a course by course basis to determine appropriate applicability to each general education category.

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## **Degree Requirements & Concentrations**

BA Competency Based Business Administration consists of 13 General Education competencies, 34 Business Core competencies and 9 to 12 emphasis area competencies.

Students may choose from the following emphases:

- 1. General Business
- 2. GIS and Data Analytics
- 3. Information Systems Management
- 4. Management and Organizational Leadership
- 5. Marketing
- 6. Supply Chain Management and Logistics

While it is possible for transfer coursework to meet competency requirements within these emphasis areas, that coursework must be reviewed by an academic dean within the School of Business and Professional Studies, to determine transferability.

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
