## Degree Requirements & Concentrations/Electives

BA Social Work consists of 42 credits of core courses and 6 credits of electives to fulfill the 48 credit requirement for the program. Students must select the 6 elective credits from a specific list.

It is possible for transfer courses to meet course requirements within the emphasis area. That coursework must be reviewed by a dean within the School of Arts and Sciences to determine transferability.
